

Terms and conditions for Heart FM Blisters for Bread 2019 Campaign

- 1 This is a promotional competition called Heart FM Blisters for Bread 2019 Campaign (the "Competition") conducted by Lucky Star Ltd (Registration Number: 1946/022718/06) of 8th Floor, Oceana House, 25 Jan Smuts Street, Foreshore, Cape Town (the "Promoter") subject to the provisions of section 36 of the Consumer Protection Act, No. 68 of 2008 as amended ("CPA") and the regulations promulgated there-under, and the terminology used in the aforesaid CPA shall apply to the Competition.
- 2 The Promotion is organised and run on behalf of the Promoter by Heart FM (Registration number: 1995/010037/07 of corner Somerset and De Smidt Streets, Green Point, Cape Town.
- 3 Except for those participants described in section 36(3)(b) of the CPA (see clause 8 below), the Competition is open to individuals who have a South African identity number/valid passport/refugee documents, are 18 years or older and are currently residing in the Republic of South Africa.
- 4 To enter the competition:
 - 4.1 Heart FM listeners must submit their Lucky Star secret meal recipe via voice note to the WhatsApp number: 082 222 1049 for a chance to win a share of R10,000.00 cash and a donation to Blisters for Bread of R5,000.00 on the winner's behalf.
 - 4.2 Two finalists will be selected on Wednesday 21 August 2019 and 22 August 2019 respectively, the finalists will each win a cash prize of R2,500.00.
 - 4.3 The finalists will be invited to prepare and bring their dishes to the Heart FM studio during the afternoon drive on Friday 23 August 2019 for a live tasting where Chef Kabelo and DJ Suga will vote for the winning dish.
 - 4.4 The winner will win a further cash prize of R5,000.00 as well as a donation on their behalf to Blisters for Bread of R5,000.00.
- 5 The competition opens on 19 August 2019 and closes at midnight on 23 August 2019.
- 6 Finalists will be contacted via the WhatsApp number they used to enter the competition and their names will be announced in studio by Chef Kabelo and DJ Suga, who will also announce the winner on 23 August 2019 after they have voted for the winning dish.
- 7 The costs of preparing the finalists' dishes and transport to and from the Heart FM studio will be for the finalists' account and the Promoter and Heart FM will not be responsible for any of these costs. The finalists must ensure that they have made the necessary transportation arrangements to attend the live tasting on the 23rd of August 2019.
- 8 The prize shall not be awarded to a director, member, partner, employee or agent of, or consultant, or their spouse, partner or members of their immediate family, of the Promoter or Heart FM or any other person who directly or indirectly controls or is controlled by, the Promoter or Heart FM, or to a supplier of goods or services in connection with the competition. The Promoter and Heart FM reserves the right to request a winner to depose an affidavit confirming that he/she does not fall within this category of persons and must further upon request be able to verify their identity by providing a certified copy of their South African identity document, valid passport or formal refugee documentation.

- 9 Prizes are not transferable and will only be given to the finalists and winner and not a representative.
- 10 If for whatever reason the winner cannot be contacted or is disqualified in terms of clause 18 below, the prize will be forfeited to the Promoter for a reselection on the same basis that the original winners were selected.
- 11 By entering this competition, the participant acknowledges and agrees that the Promoter, its agents and representatives are granted the right to invite the participant, which invitation the participant has the right to decline, participate in any marketing activity and use the footage and/or images of the participant in whole or part and in connection with the distribution, broadcasting and all advertising, marketing and promotions to do with the footage in relation to the Competition.
- 12 When a participant submits an entry and/or sends e-mails to the Promoter and / or Heart FM, that participant consents to receiving communications from the Promoter and Heart FM electronically and agrees that all agreements, notices, disclosures and other communications sent by the Promoter electronically satisfy any legal requirements, including but not limited, to the requirement that such communication should be "in writing".
- 13 A participant, by entering the competition, agrees and gives consent that the information provided to enter the competition may be stored and used for statistical purposes or for marketing purposes by the Promoter and Heart FM. Consent to use the participant's information is not a condition for entry in the competition and the participant has the right to withdraw such consent at any time by notifying the Promoter per telephone on number 021 415 8600 or per e-mail at info@luckystar.co.za.
- 14 Information collected from participants will be used by the Promoter only and will not in any way be transferred or made available to third parties except if it remains for the use by the Promoter only.
- 15 A participant will have the right to request from the Promoter details of the information held of the participant and to update and/or correct any of the information provided. - 16 No correspondence will be entered into and the Promoter's decision is final and binding, subject only to the supervision and certification of the competition by an independent accountant, registered auditor, attorney or advocate and the reporting thereon through the Promoter's internal audit reporting procedures.
- 17 When entering the competition, a participant acknowledges and agrees to these terms and conditions.
- 18 Should any participant or winner be found to be in contravention of any of these terms and conditions or in the opinion of the Promoters, engaged in conduct in entering the Competition which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill of reputation of the Promoter, the Promoter reserves the right to disqualify such a participant or winner on written notice.
- 19 WhatsApp is in no way directly or indirectly liable for any communication in all forms pertaining to the competition. The competition is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with WhatsApp and they shall in no way assume liability in whole or in part directly or indirectly, from participation in the competition by the participant or any action by the competition organisers.

- 20 The participant hereby acknowledges that any voluntary provision or disclosure of any information is provided to the Promoter and/or its organisers and not to WhatsApp.
- 21 The Promoter chooses as its *domicilium citandi et executandi* for all purposes under this competition, whether in respect of court process, notice or other documents or communication of whatsoever nature: 7th Floor, Oceana House, 25 Jan Smuts Street, Cape Town, 8001.
- 22 The Promoter has the right to terminate the competition immediately and without notice in the event that, due to reasons beyond its control, it is impossible to continue with the competition. In the event of such termination, all participants agree to waive any rights that they may have in terms of this competition and acknowledge that they will have no recourse against the Promoter, its directors, employees and agents.
